Academic Fee Refund Policy AY 2025-26

1. Below are the Refund Details on Withdrawal of Admission by the Candidate:

(a) If a candidate withdraws their admission before 15 days or more of last date of admission, the candidate will receive a 100% refund on the Semester Academic fees.

(b) If a candidate withdraws their admission between 16th day to last date of admission, the candidate will receive a 90% refund on the Semester Academic fees.

(c) If a candidate withdraws their admission within 15 days after last date of admission, the candidate will receive an 80% refund on the Semester Academic fees.

(d) If a candidate withdraws their admission after 16 days to 30 days of last date of admission, the candidate will receive a 50% refund on the Semester Academic fees.

(e) If a candidate withdraws their admission after 30 days of last date of admission, Then will be NO refund.

Sr. No	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

Academic/Tuition Fee does not include Registration fee

2. Following to be noted:

(a) IIIT- CDOE refund policy is in consonance with the provisions contained in the UGC Notification issued in Oct 2018 on Refund of Fees.

(b) The above refund details are based on the Semester Academic fees within the given payment deadlines of IIIT- CDOE, Noida.

(c) IIIT-CDOE Noida reserves the right to change, modify, add, or remove portions of the policy at any time by posting the amended policy on the website.

(d) Candidates are advised to check the policy periodically for changes.

(e) If candidate fail to qualify eligibility criteria his/her admission stands cancelled and semester/tuition fee shall be refunded.

3. To apply for a refund, candidates must send an email to the Student Support team with the duly filled Withdrawal Form attached for further processing. This request will be treated as a formal notice of withdrawal, and the refund amount will be calculated as per the guidelines mentioned in Para 1 above. Candidates must ensure that all particulars and bank details are accurately filled in the Withdrawal Form to avoid delays.
