Counselling Process

Brief describe the provision in LMS to be used by HEI :-

SWAYAM platform is used by JIIT online as ELM. It is a digital learning system designed to support online teaching, learning, assessment. ELM on SWAYAM helps integrate online courses with regular academic programs. It enables students to access video lectures, reading materials, assignments, quizzes, and discussion forums anytime and anywhere. JIIT online allows students to enroll in SWAYAM courses and evaluate their performance as per UGC guidelines. The platform promotes flexible learning, self-paced education, digital inclusion, skill enhancement, and blended learning.

Assessment mechanism	The assessment mechanism is divided into two components — Internal and External. The Internal Assessment carries 25% marks and is conducted on a continuous basis throughout the semester. It includes MCQ-based tests posted on the SWAYAM platform for each subject, weekly discussion forum questions posted by faculty where learners are required to actively participate, learner's attendance in online classes. Additionally, based on faculty discretion and course requirement, subjective assessments are also provided through the SWAYAM platform, ensuring a more comprehensive evaluation of learners. The External Assessment carries 75% marks and consists of an End-Term Examination conducted at the conclusion of each semester to evaluate the overall subject knowledge and understanding gained by the learners.
Identified technological interface and interoperability	IIT utilizes the SWAYAM portal as its primary Learning Management System, through which recorded lectures, live class links, MCQ-based assessments, and discussion forums are hosted and managed. For live interactive sessions, Zoom is used as the virtual classroom tool. The portal is accessible across desktops, laptops, and mobile phones, ensuring flexibility for all learners. Additionally, the SWAYAM portal is integrated with the institution's Student Portal through a dedicated banner and redirect link, allowing learners to access the LMS directly upon logging in, ensuring a seamless digital experience.
Learner's Authentication Requirements	Learners are enrolled on the SWAYAM portal using their registered email ID with the institution. To access the platform, learners are required to log in using the same registered email, ensuring that only verified and registered learners can access the portal. Additionally, all course materials including recorded lectures, assessments, and discussion forums are hosted under the Course Option on SWAYAM, which restricts access exclusively to enrolled learners. Any learner who has not been officially registered by the institution will not be able to view or access the course content, thereby maintaining the integrity and security of the learning environment.

	<p>"Enrollment" option within the Program Manager ID and fills in the required details such as programme name, batch, and session. A CSV file is then populated with learner details including name, email ID, batch, session, and programme ID, and uploaded to the portal, upon which the learners are successfully enrolled. Once registered, learner receive a confirmation email notifying them that they can access the SWAYAM portal using their registered email ID.</p>
Active Engagement of the Learners along with Analytics for active engagement of learners and Reporting	<p>learners are actively engaged on the SWAYAM portal through recorded lectures, e-content, MCQ-based assessments, discussion forums, and live interactive sessions conducted via Zoom. The platform provides built-in analytics where learners can monitor their own progress through a course completion percentage calculated out of 100%. Additionally, learner attendance of live classes is tracked and shared with learners directly through the Student Portal, ensuring transparency. From the institution's side, detailed reports reflecting each learner's activity such as quiz attempts, content viewed, and overall course completion can be generated through the Program Manager ID. These reports are downloaded at the end of the semester, shared with faculty members, and utilized for awarding internal assessment</p>
Payment Gateway –using Digital Payment system	<p>Learner fee payments are facilitated through the institution's Student Portal using a secure and seamless digital payment system. The payment gateway integrated is Easebuzz, which supports multiple payment modes including Net Banking, Debit Card, and UPI, ensuring convenience and flexibility for all learners. This enables learners to complete their fee payments digitally in a safe and efficient manner without any need for physical transactions.</p>
Tracking the delivery of a Course or programme	<p>To ensure timely and complete course delivery, all course materials including recorded lectures, e-content, assessments, and quizzes are uploaded on the SWAYAM portal by the respective faculty members before the commencement of each semester. However, the content is released on a weekly basis as the semester progresses, ensuring a structured and pace-appropriate learning experience for learners. Once uploaded, the content is reviewed by the technical team to verify completeness and accuracy. Further, weekly checks are conducted across all courses to ensure nothing is missing, and a report is prepared and submitted to the higher management for proper oversight and accountability. Additionally, learners can raise a support ticket directly through the Student Portal in case of any technical issue related to SWAYAM, which is resolved within 24 hours, ensuring prompt resolution and uninterrupted access to learning resources.</p>
Technical Know-how or Skills Requirements	<p>To ensure smooth and effective utilization of the SWAYAM platform, both learners and faculty members are provided with adequate training and support. For learners, a detailed briefing is conducted during the orientation programme at the time of admission. Additionally, a demo video is available for learners on the IIIT Online YouTube channel: https://youtu.be/oUrdeZnQPpl?si=C_QlnjTLNBsPj2Xc. For faculty members, internal training sessions are conducted covering all aspects of the platform including content uploading, creation of units, and setting up assessments. A dedicated technical support team is also in place to assist both learners and faculty in case of any technical difficulties. Additionally, the institution maintains regular interaction with IIT Madras for exploration of new features and updates on SWAYAM, with a quarterly sync-up call conducted to discuss platform enhancements and best practices.</p>

Network security is maintained through dedicated firewall and security systems ensuring safe and uninterrupted access to online resources. The institution has dedicated recording studios equipped with the necessary audio-visual setup for the creation of high-quality recorded lecture videos and for conducting live online classes. Faculty members utilize these studios to produce and upload course content on the SWAYAM platform. Additionally, dedicated computer laboratories are available for learners, providing them access to the required hardware and software needed to engage with the online course materials. These facilities collectively ensure that the institution is fully equipped to deliver and manage online programmes in a smooth and efficient manner.
